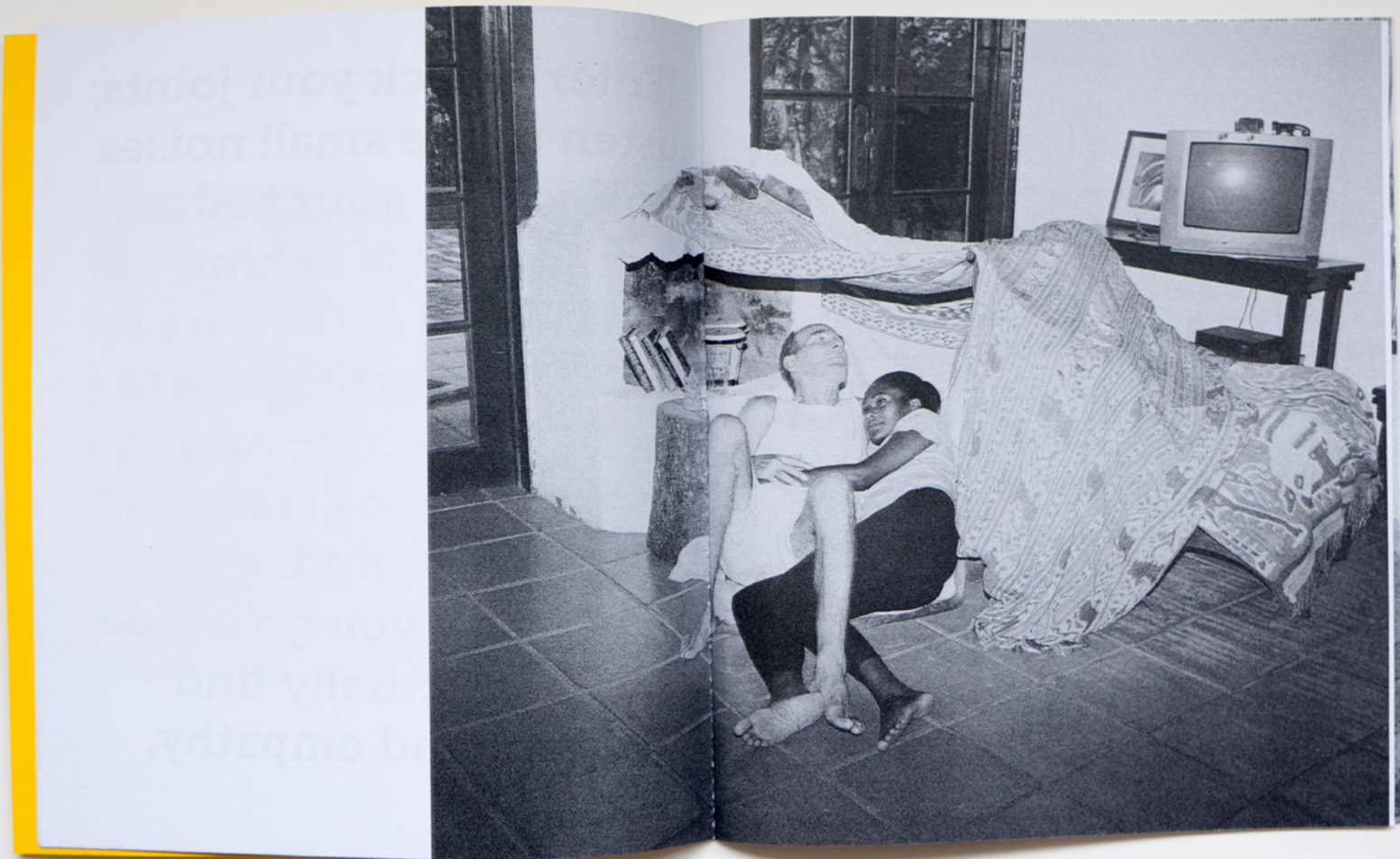
dramatically change
